

#### **GESHEMA DAMCHA:**

The Geshema degree is the highest level of training in the Gelugpa tradition, equivalent to a doctorate in Tibetan Buddhism. The Geshema degree was only formally opened to women in 2012 and nuns began taking Geshema exams in 2013. In 2016, Twenty Tibetan Buddhist nuns made history when they became the first Tibetan women to earn Geshema degrees. We feel proud that five of our nuns were among them.

On 24th January 2023, we are happy to celebrate the graduation ceremony (**GESHEMA DAMCHA**) at the nunnery's main temple. Geshemas of this year are Ven. Samten Choedeon, Ven. Jinpa Choetso, and Ven. Tashi Yangkyi la who are from Tibet and Ven. Chattan Dolkar la is from Ladakh, India.





We would like to convey our hearty congratulations and good luck to every Geshema for their success and this spiritual journey.

## **GESHEMA EXAMINATION & RESULT:-**

On auspicious Wednesday, we started the annual Tantric examination from 25th -27<sup>th</sup> January 2023. The examination is in written and debate form.

On the last day of January 2023, all nuns along with the nunnery abbot and teachers gathered in the main temple to attend the function of distributing prizes and appreciation to Tantra examiners.

❖ LOSAR is a NEW YEAR festival celebrated in Tibet and similarly by Tibetan Buddhists worldwide. This year Tibetan Losar 2023 (New Year) festival was on Tuesday, February 21.
