
Jangchub Choeling Nunnery was severely affected in the month of June as there was an implosion of Covid cases. More than 100 nuns were infected by the Corona Virus.

Sudden spike of covid positive cases in the nunnery was a huge challenges as the nunnery already has limited space and being a close knit community of more than 250 nuns. Usually, the main kitchen of nunnery provide meals of nuns. Each floor of the residence has public baths and toilets for nun to use together. Because of this, an infected case occurred, it easily spread like a wild fire and was quite difficult to control. There was an explosion of cases. Because there are many positive confirmed cases of novel corona virus in nunnery, everyone stayed in their own rooms, and volunteers and office staff continued to work in isolation. Nunnery kitchen was closed for the prevention of further spread. All dry foods were distributed to each rooms and nuns had to prepare their own meal in their own room.





In response to the epidemic situation in nunnery, we were under the guidance of settlement office and settlement hospital situated opposite to the nunnery. We received positive response from the supporters of the monastery such as **Dr. phil Carola Roloff**, **Paul Syska**, many **godparents**, the **Tibetan Center** and the **Omnis Religio Foundation**, **Tzu Chi**, **Estrella de la Mañana** (spanish NGO) in collaboration with **Karma Foundation**, many individuals, Lamas, Tulkus and Monasteries with a great individual donations . We are deeply grateful for their compassion, generosity, and precious kindness. We are grateful to individuals and groups that have provided assistance emotionally and being there with us. Medical supplies, nutritional food, medicines, oxygen concentrators.



Together, we are stronger in facing any challenges.



## 2. July and Celebration

Vinaya class of 2021 has completed their 18<sup>th</sup> year long course of studying Buddhist nalandic traditions in the nunnery. 17<sup>th</sup> nuns has completed their course. Celebration lasted a day from the scarf offering and special meal treatment to all nuns.

Nuns gathered in the main temple for the monthly puja followed by reading scriptures of Buddha and recitation of one lakh Tara prayers as to merit of all donors, supporters and sponsors of the nunnery during every thick and thin.

Summer retreat will be always followed by a week holiday called Gayi. As a week of relaxation and recreation.
